



## **TLYM Fine Arts Festival 2021 - UPDATE - 4/9/21**

We are now counting down the final days to our Fine Arts Festival. It is an exciting time because this will be our first in-person event in over a year and we cannot wait to see everyone once again.

As a courtesy, we invite you to review the update that was posted online on February 22. Information as far as guidelines for absentee entries in the unlikely event someone has COVID symptoms prior to the event, can be found there on that document.

In addition, there have been two changes to the schedule for the event.

1. All Fine Arts Presentations will take place only on Saturday, April 17 from 9 AM - 12 PM. The presentation schedule has now been posted online. There will be NO scheduled activities on Friday, April 16 and check-in will begin at 8 AM on Saturday. All art entries must be turned in at that time.
2. The second change is that after discussing it with our Executive Leadership and the local church at Vida City, we will be hosting an in-person celebration service at 1:30 PM on Saturday, April 17. The celebration service will have a maximum capacity of 250 people. We believe, as always, this will be a joyous time to celebrate the talents and giftings that God has given our students. All evaluation sheets can be picked up at the conclusion of our celebration service.

As a reminder, upon arrival, each individual will have their temperature checked upon check-in. You will receive a wristband designating that you have been screened. In addition, each individual will sign and fill out a waiver. To save time, you can pre-print this waiver from our website at [www.tlym.org/fine-arts](http://www.tlym.org/fine-arts). We encourage groups to arrive at least 30 minutes prior to your first presentation in order to accommodate for this screening time. We will not make accommodations if you are not able to make it on time to your presentation due to the additional screening time.
